## Driving Directions

### Winning Ways Stable

From Spaulding Turnpike — Take exit 9, turn left at end of the ramp. Follow road for approx. 1/2 mile to the traffic light. Take a right onto Sixth Street and follow for 0.8 miles. Turn left onto County Farm Road. Follow County Farm Road to the stop sign. Take a right onto County Farm Cross Road and Winning Ways Stable is approx. 0.3 miles on the left.

From Route 125 North or South— Travel to Route 9 intersection in Barrington, NH. Turn onto Route 9 East. Follow Route 9 East for approx. 3 miles. Take left onto French Cross Road. Follow to the end. Take a right onto Tolend Road and follow approx. 0.5 miles. Take left onto Watson Road (1st left). Follow Watson Road to the stop sign. Take a left onto County Farm Road. Follow County Farm Road to the stop sign. Take a right onto County Farm Cross Road and Winning Ways Stable is approx. 0.3 miles on the left.

### Brookfield Corner Farm

From NH Rte. 16— Turn west (toward Brookfield and Wolfeboro) at the light/Mobil station at the intersection of Rte. 109 (Wentworth Road). Brookfield Corner Farm is 1 1/2 miles on the left (south) side of the road

From Wolfeboro, NH—follow Rte 28 north away from town until you see a 7-Eleven store on the left. Turn right (East) on Rte 109 (Wentworth Road) - do not get confused with Rte 109A. Continue 7.4 miles. Brookfield Corner Farm will be on the right just past the Brookfield Town Hall.

- Returned checks will be subject to a \$25.00 fee.

USEF tests 1-19. To fill a class, at least 4 competitors must complete the course.

## Jumper Class Descriptions

**Table II, Sec. 2 (a):** In the event of equality of faults after the first round there will be on jump-off for first place only in which time will decide in the event of equality of faults incurred during the jump-off.

**Table II, Sec 2(b):** If a competitor has gone clean in the first round, the competitor will, without leaving the ring, upon an audible signal, commence the designated jump-off course.

**HUNTER BREEDING SECTION:** To be judged on confirmation, way of moving, quality, substance, soundness and suitability. Weanlings may wear halters; all yearlings and older must wear a bridle. Weanlings and broodmares to show at a walk; all others at a walk trot

**WALK-TROT EQUITATION:** Open to riders 10 years and younger as of December 1, 2009. Not to show in any other class/division at the same show. Not to show over more than 4 poles at the trot. NEHC Rated "B"

**Walk-Trot Equitation:** 6 ribbons  
**Walk-Trot Pleasure:** 6 ribbons

**LEADLINE EQUITATION:** Open to riders 8 years and younger as of December 1, 2009. Not to show in any other class/division at the same show. Not to show over more than 2 poles at the walk or the trot.

**Leadline Equitation:** 6 ribbons  
**Leadline Pleasure:** 6 ribbons  
**Leadline Poles:** 6 ribbons

**SUITABLE HUNTER DIVISION:** Open to beginning riders or horses of any age. Horse/Rider combination may not have competed at heights greater than 18" at any other show. To show over 4 to 8 fences with no combinations. May trot or canter fences.

**Suitable Hunter Under Saddle:** Max height 18". 6 ribbons  
**Suitable Hunter Over Fences:** 6 ribbons  
**Suitable Hunter Stake:** Max height 18". \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5 and 6 ribbons. To be eligible, must have entered, shown and judged in Suitable Hunter Over Fences.

**DOWNEAST PONY MEDAL:** Open to riders 17 years and under competing on ponies. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of eight fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights for sm/med ponies shall be 2'3" and large ponies shall be 2'6". 25% of the contestants, a minimum of 2 riders, shall be called back for individual testing. USEF Test 1-19

**NEW HAMPSHIRE JUNIOR MEDAL:** Fence heights not to exceed 3'0". Junior riders not must accumulate 12 points to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with a change of direction. At least 3 riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF tests 1-18.

**DOWNEAST JUNIOR MEDAL:** Open to riders 17 years and under competing on horses. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of eight fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights for sm/med ponies shall be 2'3" and large ponies shall be 2'9". 25% of the contestants, a minimum of 2 riders, shall be called back for individual testing. USEF Test 1-19

**NEW HAMPSHIRE ADULT MEDAL:** Fence heights not to exceed 2'9". Amateur riders 18 years of age and older must accumulate 12 points to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with a change of direction. At least 3 riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF tests 1-18.

**DOWNEAST MODIFIED ADULT MEDAL:** Open to amateur riders 18 years and older competing on horses. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of eight fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights shall be 2'3". 25% of the contestants, a minimum of 2 riders, shall be called back for individual testing. USEF Test 1-19

**DOWNEAST AMATEUR ADULT MEDAL:** Open to amateur riders 18 years and older competing on ponies or horses. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of eight fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights shall be 2'9". 25% of the contestants, a minimum of 2 riders, shall be called back for individual testing. USEF Test 1-19

**NEHC ADULT HUNT SEAT MEDAL:** Open to adult members of the New England Horseman's Council. All contestants required to perform over eight fences not to exceed 3'. One or more individual tests of the top four contestants may be requested at the judge's discretion. USEF tests 1-19. To fill a class, at least four competitors must complete the course

## Medal Class Descriptions

**DOWNEAST WALK TROT POLES MEDAL:** Open to riders 14 years and under. Must not have shown over fences higher than 18". Contestant shall be required to show at a trot over minimum of four rails on the ground. 25% of contestants, at least 2, shall be called back for testing. Verbal testing recommended.

**NEW HAMPSHIRE 18" NOVICE MEDAL:** Fence heights not to exceed 18". Junior and adult riders not having shown over 18" at a recognized show must accumulate 12 points to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with a change of direction. At least 3 riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF tests 1-18.

**DOWNEAST JUNIOR MINI-MEDAL:** Open to riders 17 years and under competing on ponies or horses. Riders must not compete during the year in equitation classes over fences that exceed 18". Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of eight fences with at least one change of direction. Fence heights shall be 18". 25 % of the contestants, at least 2, shall be called b testing. USEF Test 1-8.ack for individual

**NEW HAMPSHIRE 2'3" MODIFIED AMATEUR ADULT MEDAL:** Fence heights not to exceed 2'3". Amateur riders 18 years of age and older who have not shown over 2'6" at a recognized show must accumulate 12 points to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with a change of direction. At least 3 riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF tests 1-18.

**NEW HAMPSHIRE CHILDREN'S MEDAL 2'3":** Fence heights not to exceed 2'3". Junior riders not having shown over 2'6" at a recognized show must accumulate 12 points to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with a change of direction. At least 3 riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF tests 1-18.

**DOWNEAST CHILDREN'S MEDAL CLASS:** Open to riders 17 years or under competing on ponies or horses. Contestants shall be required to perform over a minimum of eight fences with at lease on change of direction. Fence heights shall be 2'3". 25% of the contestants, a minimum of 2 riders, shall be called back for individual testing. USEF Test 1-8

**NEW HAMPSHIRE PONY MEDAL:** Fence heights not to exceed 2'3" for small and medium ponies, and 2'6" for large ponies. Junior pony riders must accumulate 12 points to qualify. Riders will be required to perform over a minimum of 8 fences with a change of direction. At least 3 riders must complete the course. Testing is optional and is at the discretion of the judge. USEF tests 1-18.

**SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER DIVISION:** Open to riders 12 years and younger as of December 1, 2009. May not compete in any other hunter divisions at any show and has not competed in a jumping class where fences are higher than 18". May not compete in any other classes at this show with fences higher than 18". Fences will be set at 18".

NEHC Rated "B"

**Short Stirrup Hunter Under Saddle:** 6 ribbons

**Short Stirrup Hunter Over Fences:** Max height 18". 6 ribbons

**Short Stirrup Hunter Stake:** Max height 18". \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5 and 6 ribbons. To be eligible, must have entered, shown and judged in Short Stirrup Hunter Over Fences.

**SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION:** Open to riders 12 years and younger as of December 1, 2009. Not to compete in any other equitation classes at any show except Short Stirrup Hunter Division and has not competed in jumping classes over 18". NEHC Rated "B"

**Short Stirrup Equitation on the Flat:** 6 ribbons

**Short Stirrup Equitation Over Fences:** 6 ribbons

**ADULT BEGINNER WALK-TROT DIVISION:** Open to adult riders 18 years and older as of December 1, 2009. Has not cantered in any previous show. Rider may walk or trot fences.

**Walk-Trot Equitation:** 6 ribbons

**Walk-Trot Hunter:** 6 ribbons

**Walk-Trot Hunter Over Fences:** Max height 18". 6 ribbons

**PRE-GREEN HUNTER DIVISION:** Open to horses and ponies in their first two years of showing. Maximum two years in this division. Cannot have jumped higher than 2'3" in any other division. Simple changes of lead should not be penalized. NEHC Rated "C"

**Pre-Green Hunter Under Saddle:** 6 ribbons

**Pre-Green Hunter Over Fences:** Max height 2'3". 6 ribbons

**Pre-Green Hunter Stake:** Max height 2'3". \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5 and 6 ribbons. To be eligible, must have entered, shown and judged in Pre-Green Hunter Over Fences.

**HUNT SEAT EQUITATION:** Shown at the walk, trot and canter. \ NEHC Rated "B"

**Under 12 Over Fences:** Max height 2'3". 6 ribbons

**12-14 Over Fences:** Max height 2'6". 6 ribbons

**12-14 on the Flat:** 6 ribbons

**15-17 on the Flat:** 6 ribbons

**15-17 Over Fences:** Max height 3'. 6 ribbons

**SPECIAL JUNIOR HUNTER DIVISION:** Open to riders 17 years and younger as of December 1, 2009. Open to horse/rider combinations that have not competed previously in a class with fence heights greater than 2'3". Fences will not exceed 2'3". Horses and ponies to show on same course. Horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any other open hunter division, except equitation and medal classes. May be split if 8 or more entries.

**Special Jr. Hunter Under Saddle:** 6 ribbons

**Special Jr. Hunter Over Fences:** Max height 2'3". 6 ribbons

**Special Jr. Hunter Stake:** Max height 2'3". \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5 and 6 ribbons. To be eligible, must have entered, shown and judged in Special Junior Hunter Over Fences.

**MODIFIED JUNIOR EQUITATION:** Open to riders 17 years and younger as of December 1, 2009. Riders cannot have shown in classes over 2'3" at any show, and cannot cross-enter into any other equitation division.

**Modified Jr. Equitation on the Flat:** 6 ribbons

**Modified Jr. Equitation Over Fences:** Max height 2'3". 6 ribbons

**MODIFIED ADULT EQUITATION:** Open to riders 18 years and older as of December 1, 2009. Riders cannot have shown in classes over 2'3" at any show, and cannot cross-enter into any other equitation division.

**Modified Adult Equitation on the Flat:** 6 ribbons

**Modified Adult Equitation Over Fences:** Max height 2'3".  
6 ribbons

**SPECIAL ADULT HUNTER DIVISION:** Open to amateur adult riders 18 years or older as of December 1, 2009. Horse/rider combinations may not have competed previously in a class with fence heights greater than 2'3". Fences will not exceed 2'3". Horses and ponies to show on same course. Horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any other hunter division, except equitation and medal classes. May be split if 8 or more entries.

**Special Adult Hunter Under Saddle:** 6 ribbons

**Special Adult Hunter Over Fences:** Max height 2'3". 6 ribbons

**Special Adult Hunter Stake:** Max height 2'3". \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5 and 6 ribbons. To be eligible, must have entered, shown and judged in Special Adult Hunter Over Fences.

**HUNTER PLEASURE:** Open to all horses of a hunter type ordinarily used for pleasure purposes. To be judged at walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. May be asked to hand gallop, halt and back. Light contact with horse's mouth is required. To be judged on performance, manners, suitability, substance and soundness. No limits on status of rider. NEHC Rated "C"

**Hunter Pleasure:** 6 ribbons

**Hunter Pleasure Championship:** 6 ribbons

**NEHC PLEASURE:** Open to NEHC members. Open to all horses or ponies ordinarily used for pleasure purposes, with no limits on status of rider or place of residence. To be shown at walk, trot and canter. Will be asked to back. Loose rein on command of judge only, but without loss of contact. Shall be judged on manners, performance and quality in that order. NEHC Rated "C"

**NEHC Pleasure:** 6 ribbons

**OPEN SPECIAL HUNTER DIVISION:** Open to all riders regardless of status. Fences will not exceed 2'6". May be split if 8 or more entries.

**Open Special Hunter Under Saddle:** 6 ribbons

**Open Special Hunter Over Fences:** Max height 2'6". 6 ribbons

**Open Special Hunter Stake:** Max height 2'6". \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5 and 6 ribbons. To be eligible, must have entered, shown and judged in Open Special Hunter Over Fences.

**AMATEUR ADULT HUNTER DIVISION:** Open to amateur riders 18 years or older as of December 1, 2009. Fences not to exceed 2'9". To be judged on performance, soundness, manners and way of going. NEHC Rated "B"

**Amateur Adult Hunter Under Saddle:** 6 ribbons

**Amateur Adult Hunter Over Fences:** Max height 2'9". 6 ribbons

**Amateur Adult Hunter Stake:** Max height 2'9". \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5 and 6 ribbons. To be eligible, must have entered, shown and judged in Amateur Adult Hunter Over Fences.

**AMATEUR ADULT EQUITATION:** Open to amateur riders 18 years or older as of December 1, 2009. Fences not to exceed 2'9". NEHC Rated "B"

**Amateur Adult Equitation on the Flat:** 6 ribbons

**Amateur Adult Equitation Over Fences:** Max height 2'9".  
6 ribbons

**CHILDREN'S HUNTER DIVISION:** To be shown by junior exhibitors. Junior exhibitors 15-17 years of age must be eligible for intermediate equitation over fences (have not won 12 blue ribbons) as of December 1, 2009. Fences set at 3'. Spreads not to exceed fence height. Same horse/rider combination cannot show in any other classes at show except equitation classes and Open Special Hunter Division. Horses may be shown by another rider in any other division or class at the same show. Includes ponies small & large and horses. Shall be judged on performance and soundness. NEHC Rated "B"

**Children's Hunter Under Saddle:** 6 ribbons

**Children's Hunter Over Fences:** Max height 3'. 6 ribbons

**Children's Hunter Stake:** Max height 3'. \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5 and 6 ribbons. To be eligible, must have entered, shown and judged in Children's Hunter Over Fences.
