GENERAL RULES:

Entry Fees: \$10 – Regular and Downeast Medal Classes
\$15 – Championship Classes

Entries must be received by fax, mail, or hand delivery by 6:00pm the Friday before the show or a post entry fee of \$15 per horse/pony and rider combination will be charged. Pre-entries may add classes on show day with no penalty.

In the event of severe weather the show may be cancelled. This decision will be made by 6:00pm the Saturday before. Please call or check the website if in doubt!

There will be a brief warm-up before each jumping division (no fee).

The indoor arena is large, bright and airy. It is insulated but not heated. There is an inside waiting area for horses and riders, as well as a heated viewing area for spectators. (see website for pictures!)

Awards: Trophy and six ribbons per class
Championship trophy and ribbon
Reserve Championship ribbon

Championships will be awarded at each show as well as for the show series. (see Class Descriptions)

A High-Point Trainer Trophy will be awarded to the trainer whose riders and horses have earned the most points for ribbons won over the entire Winter Show Series.

All classes will be conducted and judged under the rules of the Maine Hunter/Jumper Association.

Participants must be current members of MeHJA for points to count toward year-end awards.

The show management reserves the right to cancel, vary, or combine any class as entries warrant.

Entry fee must be paid or open check left before an exhibitor's number will be issued. A processing fee of \$35 will be charged for each non-negotiable check. Any exhibitor leaving the show with unpaid entries will be billed for these charges and an additional \$35 billing fee will be added to the total.

All ages are as of 12/1/09.

The Judges decisions are final. No exhibitor or person shall approach the judge as to a decision or other matter unless they first obtain permission from the Show Manager. Show management will cancel all entries of any exhibitor disregarding this rule, and all entry fees will be forfeited.

The Judge or Show Manager may excuse any horse, rider, or spectator considered unsound, unmanageable, or discourteous. Entry fees will be forfeited.

All dogs *must* be leashed!!!! No exceptions!

All mounted riders anywhere on the competition grounds must wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. It is the responsibility of the adult rider, or the parent, guardian, or trainer of juniors to see to it that the headgear worn complies with such standard.

Any exhibitor may wear a protective safety vest specifically designed for equestrian sport in any division or class without penalty from the Judge. It is recommended that the vest meet or surpass the current ASTM standard or be certified by the SEI.

A copy of a negative Coggins test dated within one year of the show date is required for every horse.

Brookfield Corner Farm, LLC, it's owners and employees, the property owners, and show personnel will not be held responsible for injury, theft, or damage to any person, property, or animal. Signature on entry form and/or presence on show grounds constitutes this agreement.

NO FOOD ON GROUNDS. We ask that each exhibitor bring something for "pot luck". There are tables and places to plug in crock pots in the lounge. BCF will provide napkins, plastic silverware, and paper plates. Coffee and donuts will be for sale.

DIRECTIONS:

From NH Rt.16 – turn west (towards Brookfield and Wolfeboro) at the light/Mobil station at the intersection of Rt. 109 (Wentworth Rd.) BCF is 1 ½ miles on the left (south) side of the road.

From Wolfeboro, NH – follow Rt.28 north away from town until you see a *7-Eleven* store on the left. Turn right (east) on Rt. 109 (Wentworth Rd.) – do not get confused with Rt.109A. Continue 7.4 miles. BCF will be on the right just past the Brookfield Town Hall.
